EyeCrème Clinical, Consumer, and Safety Results

Brighter-looking. Smoother-looking. Measured at eight weeks.

EyeCrème brings richer AM/PM eye-area moisture together with measured radiance and wrinkle-appearance responder rates, a separate consumer-perception study, and ophthalmologist-tested reassurance for contact-lens wearers.

Participants with measured improvement in eye-area skin radiance at week 8.

WRINKLE RESPONDERS

Participants with a measured decrease in eye-area wrinkle appearance at week 8.

HOW THE MEASURED RESULT WAS PRODUCED

Independent eight-week clinical study · 31 participants · expert grading and Visioscan analysis compared with baseline. These are responder rates: the share of participants who achieved measured change, not the mean percentage change in the endpoint.

WHERE EYECRÈME FITS

Use EyeCrème as the richer eye-area moisture step after facial moisturizer, morning and evening. If NeoTight Eye Serum is also in the routine, the lighter treatment goes first; EyeLuminator remains the separate sheer morning makeup brightener.

SEPARATE EIGHT-WEEK CONSUMER STUDY

What Participants Saw and Felt

Consumer agreement adds the lived eye-area finish to the measured responder story. Each percentage below is the share of 31 participants who agreed with that statement after eight weeks.

83.87% lines and wrinkles appeared diminished

80.65% eye area looked more rested

77.42% eye area looked smoother and more awake

74.19% eye area looked more radiant

70.97% eye area looked refreshed and less crepey

IMMEDIATE FEEL AND EYE-AREA REASSURANCE

A majority also agreed that the eye area immediately felt hydrated and that crow's-feet appearance looked reduced; the official page does not publish percentages for those two statements. EyeCrème is ophthalmologist-tested and described as safe for contact-lens wearers.
